Subj: - Problem faced by villagers by Jarawa interference - regarding.

Sir,

With due respect I am to lay down the following few line for your kind consideration a necessary action please

1. That Sir, the jarawas usually come always ever day and night and stay in temporary hut and Collinpur, Tirur & Herbertabad village and create great lose the villagers/cultivation taking away coconut, banana and other agricultural products and they disturbed the settler family.
2. That Sir, the police strength in JPP Camp No I & IV may be increased and also more opportunities to the local youth may be provided for the protection of the agricultural products damaged by the Jarawas.
3. That Sir, after Tsunami 40% paddy field at Tirur, Herbertabad & Collinpur village has been affected by the Saline water and the villagers depend on hilly land for agriculture products. And it is regretted to mention here that the poor people in spite of facing huge loss in Tsunami and jarawa destruction, no compensation is provided by the Administration.
4. That Sir, in Tirur village of Tushnabad Panchayat there is a provision for construction of Dispensary for the Jarawas but till date no dispensary has been constructed and in jarawas are brought for medical treatment at PHC Tushnabad. In this regard it is to request you that necessary arrangement may kindly be made for the early construction of dispensary at Tirur for jarawas so that the public getting treated in PHC Tushnabad are not be disturbed.

Therefore I request you to kindly look into the matter and provide suitable solution to the above said problem.
