

The fishermen going out to sea near Jhaokona (Jarawa Reserve) through creek are unchecked by the Jarawa Protection Police-4 now based at Collinpur.

At mouth of the Herbertabad creek few Jarawa girls are camped. These girls are in communication often with the local fishermen. We cannot take action against them and the reasons are clear that 1) They don't get down from their dinghy but entice/coerce the Jarawas in the manner that the tribes themselves come to them and secondly 2) They camp along the edges of the reserve.
