Sir,

You know that the Administration is putting all its efforts in managing the Jarawa situation at various places including Tirur to protect the interest of the Jarawa community and their avoidance of interaction with the non-tribal population. The sincere efforts made by the staff of AAJVS and Police Department is not showing the desired results at Tirur sector and due to which the Jarawas interaction is increasing with the non-tribals for various activities. The situation is not only monitored by the NGOs from outside the country but also the local printed media and highlights issues every now and then.

In order to streamline the system and to make the system effective this office has already shifted some AAJVS staff from Tirur area and new staff are posted. Now it is come to our knowledge that some Police persons are involved with the villagers who are frequently interact with the tribals for their vested interest. Unless some of them are not replaced, the situation will deteriorate further.

You are, therefore, requested to look into this factual position and take necessary action in replacing some of the Police persons from Tirur section and post some sensible staff to deal with the situation.
