It has been reported by the field functionaries of this Organization posted at Tirur area that the local settlers are involved on poaching activities in the Jarawa reserve areas of South Andaman. In most of the cases, it is found that there are repeated offenders.

This issues was discussed during the 3rd meeting of the Research Advisory Board of ANTRI on 30th December 2013, wherein the Secretary (TW) and the experts have taken a serious note on it. The Secretary (TW) directed to list out the repeated offenders and take necessary action under provisions of the IPC / Cr/ PC along with PAT so that they are not let out on bail.

Considering the seriousness of the case, you are requested to identify the repeated offenders involved in poaching activities in Jarawa areas and initiate necessary action as per provisions of the law.
