
Sub: Monitoring activities of repeated offenders- reg.  
Sir,

It has been reported by the field functionaries of this Organization posted at Tirur area that the local settlers are involved on poaching activities in the Jarawa reserve areas of South Andaman. In most of the cases, it is found that there are repeated offenders.

A meeting with the Panchayati raj Institution members was held in the community hall at Herbertabad where the representative of Police department was also present. It was revealed during the meeting that there were cases of repeated offenders who violated the provisions of the PAT Regulations. The members asked for taking stern action against the repeated offenders.


You are therefore requested to direct your officials to keep a strict watch on those habitual and repeated offenders / poachers who enter in Jarawa area of Tirur with vested motives so that no incident may occur. Necessary action may be taken under provisions of the PAT Regulations and provisions of other laws
