New Zealand paceman Kyle Mills said it would be 'a strange feeling' for him to play against an Indian ODI line-up without Sachin Tendulkar and Virender Sehwag.

Mills said, "Every time I bowled to Sehwag on this ground he's got a hundred so I'm pleased he's not there. It's a new-look Indian side but it's a team performing well on the international stage. They play a lot more cricket than us." The paceman said the Kiwis would seek to make early inroads. "Hopefully we can get into their top order. It's a different Indian side to what we've faced over the last decade. There are new players on the scene with a bit of hype about them. Kohli is obviously a quality player and (Shikhar) Dhawan has done a pretty good job at the top of the order. Hopefully we can bowl tightly to them and create some pressure that way."
