During the meeting, the Principal Secretary (Rev) and Deputy Commissioner (South Andaman) were informed that the Tourism Department were requesting for the same land. They therefore carried out an inspection of the land requested for by the Rajiv Gandhi Centre for Aquaculture. It was noted that the site is on the way to Chidyatapu and that the Tourism Department have separately requested for this land for a hotel.

After considering all aspects it was felt that this site is more suited to a tourism project, and it was decided not to approve the proposal of the Rajiv Gandhi Centre for Aquaculture. The Deputy Commissioner shall locate suitable land elsewhere for them.

3. Allotment of land to AAJVS
(RC No. 1358/DCSA /2013)

The Deputy Commissioner informed that a meeting was held in the conference hall of Secretariat on 04/07/2012 and 15/10/2013 under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary regarding allotment of land at Tirur for raising eco-huts for Jarawas. Accordingly, the department AAJVS submitted a proposal in prescribed format for allotment of 1000 Sq. Mtrs. of land. Based on the requisition the District Administration identified 0.10 hectares of land at Temple Myo which is 200 Mtrs. beyond the HTL. The Deputy Commissioner further certified that the land requisitioning agency has fulfilled all criteria prescribed in Land Allotment Policy, 2013.

The Committee recommended the proposal for allotment of 0.10 hectares of land at Temple Myo to AAJVS for construction of eco-friendly Jarawa Ward
