

AAJVS:-

1. The TWO has been directed to hear the grievances of tribes and if it is beyond his competency, then immediately he should report to his seniors for immediate redressal of the grievances.
2. The Andamanese demanded replacement of existing 500 liter capacity water tank (syntax) with 1000 liter water tank (syntax) for each house hold.
3. Netting of the poultry by the TWO
4. Provision of gas connection of the interested family.
5. Demarcation of garden by mean of rope by TWO.
6. Strengthening of bars of the garden by mean of bamboo on payment basis in collaboration with the forest department.
7. Owner of 3 private house demanded that the Administration should repair their private house.
8. The Andamanese demanded construction of retaining wall at New Basthi to prevent any future land sliding.
9. Provision of 5 volley ball and 2 nets for the Andamanese. 1 set of cricket kit shall also be provided.
10. Revival of the traditional festivals of the Andamanese tribe to develop a sense of common brotherhood among them.

After returning back to Port Blair, the team also interacted the Jarawa tribes and field officials of AAJVS. Actionable points:

1. Entry and exit point of convey vehicle are good place for creating awareness on Tribal issues. Do's and Don'ts sign board (small boards with one instruction in neon light) shall be installed here in the vicinity of hundred mtrs.
2. Existing boards needs to be repaired and replaced with new one.
3. Sanitization of all stake holders living near JTR especially in Uttar Panchayat, Kadamtala Panchayat and Kausalya Nagar Panchayat.
4. Office of AAJVS at Jirkatang needs to be operational zed for sanitization and information emancipation. Pamphlets containing information on JTR should be distributed here amongst the Tour Operator and Tourists during their halt at Jirkatang. Laminated guidelines shall be handed over to the
