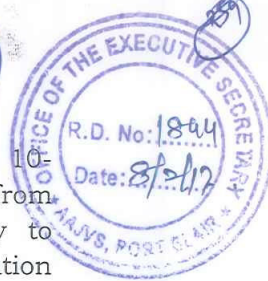

PUC is the note bearing no. F. No. 10-14/DHS/TH/MMU/2016-17/115 dated 12/01/2017 from Deputy Director (TH) addressed to ES AAJVS with copy to Secretary (TW) and Director (ANTRI) on the subject of utilization of the funds (Rs. 1 Crore) released by Govt. of India Ministry of Tribal Affairs to AAJVS under CCD programme.

Deputy Director (Tribal Health) has discussed about the machine and manpower required for proposed Mobile Medical Units (MMU) meant for Jarawa and Shompen tribes. The perusal of details indicates the provision of Rs 6, 50, 000/- only for the purpose of motor vehicle /ambulance on which MMU will be mounted.

It is apparent that four wheeler vehicle proposed will not be big enough to carry all machines, equipments including mini OT. The minibus type ambulance instead of jeep type ambulance would be suitable which can carry all equipments and the team to man the MMU.

As such, the matter may be looked into and Deputy Director (TH) may be requested to relook into the suitability of the vehicle proposed by his note mentioned above.

Further, a request may have to be sent to the A & N unit of National Health Mission to provide for the manpower required for MMU right in the earnest as they would require some time to consider such request.
