22	<p>This is a report furnished by Shri. Anup Kumar Mondal, Tribal Welfare Officer, AAJVS stating that during his recent visit to Middle Strait area, the Jarawa made complain that their traditional food resources are depleting due to frequent poaching by the civilians.</p>
23	<p>In order to find out the fact, he initiated an inquiry and visited all Jarawa camps between Jirkatang and Middle Strait and found shocking information about frequent poaching by civilians.</p>
	<p>He has given an area wise report areas briefed as under:-</p>
	<p>a) <u>Potatang area:</u> Jarawas reported that residents of Wrightmyo, Shoal bay come to Potatang area in engine dinghy during night for fishing and hunting. Some poachers enter Potatang during night armed with gun and motor bike which they bring in engine dinghy through the creek of B.D. Nallah. They stay in the reserve area for collection of forrest produces also. There were evidences of killing of wild boar and deer near the newly constructed hot spot area.</p>
	<p>b) <u>R.K. Nallah area:-</u> The Jarawas of R.K. nallah reported that the residents of Baratang, flat bay and Kadamtala area are the frequent poachers of Badabalu and Leyatal for fishing and hunting.</p>
	<p>c) <u>Kadamtala area:-</u> The residents of Phooltala, Kadamtala, kausallya nagar, Bornial, Chainpur, Mayabunder, Kalaphad areas frequently venture in to the Jarawa area like Dhani Nallah, Philip Nallah, lakra Lungta, Spike island, Yearterjig, Kausallya Nagar andf western coast of Middle Andaman area with dogs and traps for hunting of wild animals.</p>
24	<p>Jarawa of western coast of Middle Andaman reported that they are not getting adequate fish like earlier due to frequent fishing activities undertaken by fishermen from junglighat, dairy farm and Kadamtala. The fishermen use gadgets for which fishing that are banned by the Fisheries department.</p>
25	<p>The poachers sell sliced meat of wild boar and deer in local market through chicken centers or other ways to earn money. Shri. Anup Kumar Mondal has requested to take immediate action to check and control poaching activities in the Jarawa area.</p>
