Altogether 14 persons have  
been apprehended by

violation of PAT  
Regulation, 1956.

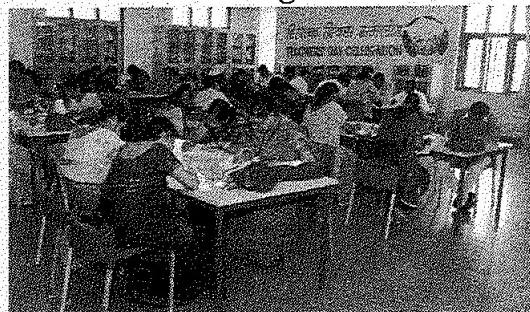
On reports of  
clandestine poaching of  
food reserves in the Jarawa  
Reserve Area, several Police  
teams have been actively  
patrolling and checking all  
activities. On Aug 29, 2013,  
during a joint sea patrolling,  
11 persons of Panighat and  
Dignabad were

apprehended for  
trespassing in the Jarawa  
area at Spike Island for  
fishing. Three engine  
dinghies and fishing lines  
along with 40 kg fishes were  
seized from them. They were
