30. Dr. R.K. Bhattacharya while discussing about the time schedule for third phase of survey among the Jarawas mentioned about Durga Puja and officials particularly Bengali Officials in the survey would not be willing to participate whole heartedly. Further in this context, Director of Health Services also made a mention about the foreign assignment of Dr. R. Thulsidasan in the month of September 2002. Dr. Tulasidasan is the main Officer connected with the health and nutritional survey among the

31. After further deliberations it was decided as under:

Jarawa.

- (i) The members of the Expert Committee shall be sending their comments and views on the integrated report prepared based on the second phase of survey before the commencement of third phase survey among Jarawas.
- (ii) The third phase of survey among the Jarawas would start sometime during first half of August 2002.
- (iii) Chief Wild Life Warden, A&N Administration shall take immediate decisions to consider permission to take animals from the Jarawa Forest by Zoological Survey of India for their identification and study. He shall issues permit as per the law keeping in view the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta in Jarawa Case.
- (iv) Director of Health Services A&N Administration shall identify quickly the officials to conduct the diet and nutrition survey during the third phase among Jarawas.
- (v) Professor Indira Chakravorthy shall send one or two suitable Officers to train these officers and officials identified by DHS early so that they are well prepared before the third phase of survey commences.
- (vi) TA /DA for such Officers of the All India Institute of the Public Hygiene & Health will be borne as in the past by AAJVS.
- (vii) Professor Indira Chakravorthy shall arrange for analysis and report writing after the third phase of Diet and Nutritional survey.
- (viii) The Administration shall consider to pay suitable honorarium to all those officials who are involved in each phase of survey taking into account very difficult and challenging task they performed.
- (ix) To facilitate for proper diet survey among the Jarawas during third phase of survey each Composite Groups may split into two subjectwise Sub groups as under:
  - (a) Health & Nutrition (Directorate of Health Services)
