- (b) Anthropology (Anthropological Survey of India), Botany (Botanical Survey of India), Forestry (Forest Department) and Zoology (Zoological Survey of India).
- (x) Each sub-group shall be provided with one vehicle and one motor dinghie during the survey. The Co-ordinator of the Composite Groups will be authorized to hire additional vehicles and motor dinghy from the selected Tenders whenever required in the field.
- (xi) As in the past, ration articles and cooking arrangements shall be made during the third phase. Mineral water be supplied to the members for drinking purpose keeping in view the current monsoons (water would be muddy in all streams in Forest and would not be suitable for drinking. Consumptions of unsafe water by team members may result into outbreak of epidemic which would be dangerous for not only team members but the Jarawas too).
- (xii) Director of Shipping Services, A&N Administration shall provide sea-worth vessel (like MV Shompen) during third phase of survey.
- (xiii) Sectoral Departments shall submit the list of the items required for the third phase of the survey quickly.
- (xiv) All the field officials of the AAJVS who have learnt Jarawa language will be deployed as interpreter during the third phase.
- (xv) As in the second phase Forest Department shall organize arrangements in the camps including cooking etc.
- (xvi) Jarawas camps will be scouted in advance by AAJVS and Forest officials. Forest Department will send the concerned officials to the field a day or two in advance to erect the camps before the actual survey commences by Composite Groups.
- (xvii) The members of the Expert Committee shall visit the field during the third phase of survey.
- (xviii) The date for next meeting of the Expert Committee shall be communicated subsequently.
