135 This is regarding payment of bills in
connection with supply of ration articles to
the composite team members who had
undergone the 3rd phase of Jarawa study in
pursuance of the Order of Calcutta High
Court w.r.t. WP 48 of 1999. Study among
the Jarawa was done as per the Orders of
the High Court. The administrative approval
for procurement of ration articles was
accorded by the competent authority, copies
placed at page 220 to 234/C.

136 These ~~are~~ items are not
stores/stationery items and neither are they
of routine use for the functioning of daily
affairs of AAJVS. AAJVS had invited tenders
with the approval of the competent
authority for the second phase of Jarawa
study in the month of April 2002 and with
the approval of the competent authority the
rates quoted by the firms for the 2nd phase
was accepted for the 3rd phase too. It is
practically not possible to receive the goods
from the firms at Baratang, Tirur and
Ferrargunj to supply the same to AAJVS
office for stock purposes and then AAJVS
has to arrange vehicles and staff for supply
of the materials from Port Blair to the
respective camps in Jarawa reserved
territories.
