


collect the information relating to the natural resources available for Jarawas. In identifying the species of the plants and animals the expertise available with the Botanical Survey of India and Zoological Survey of India could be utilized. The representative from the Forest Department also agreed that he will prepare the questionnaire on the resources and send the same before 3.11.2001.

(91) It was decided that the questionnaire and manual to be sent by Anthropological Survey of India, Botanical Survey of India, Zoological Survey of India, and Forest Department could be finalized before 5.11.2001 in consultation with Shri Mukopadhyay of Anthropological Survey of India.

(92) The matter relating to get the representative from Zoological Survey of India and Botanical Survey of India to be the members of Composite Groups and only be decided by Expert Committee since it was the decision of the Committee to incorporate the representatives from these organizations.

(93) The representative from the Health Department informed that there is no need for manual to use the questionnaire they have already formulated because this questionnaire will be canvassed by the doctors themselves.



