

- (ii) To prevent contacts with the Jarawas by unauthorized persons. To take penal measures against the encroachers, poachers and who destroy the forest and also against the police and civil administrative authorities who are negligent in taking steps against the poachers, encroachers and destructor of forest.

The tribals are not allowed to mix with the non-tribals indiscriminately. Patrolling is being conducted regularly both on land and in sea creeks with the help of trucks, jeeps and boats. Two boats have been stationed at JPP Tirur NO.4 and PS Kadamtala for this purpose. The police is preventing violation of PAT laws in all the tribal areas and is taking stern action against the violators/tress passers. The action taken in recent past is given below.
