iv. It is essential to have members of Zoological Survey of India and Botanical Survey of India. Since the local Office of these Surveys are grossly under-staffed presently, hence personnel from other Stations may have to be mobilized to participate in the study of Jarawas. So Administration may have to take up with the Director General of both these Surveys.

vi. Experts from All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi and Indian Council of Medical Research may study the morbidity and other disease related issues and suggest the drug regime for the Jarawas. The Regional Medical Research Center, Port Blair being the Center of ICMR located in these Islands could collaborate effectively the study on Jarawas.

vii. It would be desirable to try Homeopathy medicines among the Jarawas. It would be more safe to administer homeo medicines compared to allopathic drugs to Jarawas. For this, Government Homeopaths could visit Jarawas frequently for the purpose of diagnosis and study and to prepare the reports on the administration of the Homeopathic treatment among the Jarawas.

viii. To facilitate the preparation report by the Expert Committee, it is essential to have the feed back from the concerned Department like Police, Forest, Health and Andaman Adim Janjati Vikas Samiti etc. on the problems faced by them and experiences in dealing with the Jarawas ever since the change in the Jarawa's behaviour.

ix. The study team should not be very large at any point of time at Jarawas camp. This will not only hinder the study of various aspects of the Jarawas by respective team Members but also may not be acceptable to the Jarawas themselves. As such, the study teams could be categorized into two groups - (a) the teams that would study Health and Nutrition and (b) natural resources available for Jarawas. Both these categories of the team should have anthropologist as one of their members. These groups can chalk out their movement in the Jarawas area separately and cover all the bands as far as possible.
