- 11. Shri S. A. Awaradi, Director (TW) placed before the Committee the issue regarding the scrutiny / suggestion by National level experts before the same are finalized. Further the Director (Tribal Welfare) suggested for finalization of the schedule of the field work by the Composite Groups.
- 12. After detailed discussion and deliberation the Expert Committee decided as under: -
 - (i) Administration will take up the matter with Directors General of Zoological Survey of India and Botanical Survey of India to provide the manpower for the Composite Group for the study of the Jarawas.
 - (ii) All India Institute of Medical Sciences and Regional Medical Research Centre (RMRC) will undertake longitudinal research among the Jarawas on the health and the drug regime for the Jarawas.
 - (iii) Homeopathy could also be tried for the Jarawas as it is comparatively more safer from the point of view of the side effects etc. The local Homeopath shall visit the Jarawa areas for treatment and preparation of the report.
 - (iv) The report from the Police, Forest, Health and Andaman Adim Janjati Vikas Samiti Officials will be obtained on the matters relating to difficulties they encountered while dealing with the Jarawas and their experiences in the matter.
 - (v) The size of the Composite Group shall be small enough. Hence, the resources study group consisting of persons from Zoological Survey of India, Botanical Survey of India, Forest Department along with the Anthropologist shall move independent of the other category of the Group consisting of persons from Health, Nutrition and Anthropology.
 - (vi) All necessary logistics like arrangements for the shipping etc. will be made by the concerned Departments like Tribal Welfare, Andaman Adim Janjati Vikas Samiti, Directorate of Shipping Services, Directorate of IP&T etc.
 - (vii) Three handsets of Global Positioning System (GPS) of the latest variety shall be procured by the Andaman Adim Janjati Vikas Samiti and issued to the Composite Group for the use in the Jarawa areas
