(xvi) To meet the expenses relating to the study by the Expert Committee / Composite Group, funds available with the AAJVS shall be utilized in the first instance. Government of India will be requested to release additional funds under Special Central Assistance to meet the requirements by the Expert Committee as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta. Such additional funds under Special Central Assistance will then be reimbursed to Andaman Adim Janjati Vikas Samiti.
