- (viii) The tents required by the Composite Group shall be arranged by mobilizing the same from the Department of Information, Publicity and Tourism, failing which by procurement from the market by the Administration.

- (ix) A crash course on Jarawa language shall be arranged by inviting the linguists from Anthropological Survey of India and Central Institute of Indian Language, Mysore. A reference to this effect will be made to these Organizations immediately by Administration.
- (x) The members of the Expert Committee are competent enough to finalize the questionnaires. Accordingly the questionnaires on Health, Nutrition, Culture and Behaviour (Anthropology) are finalized herewith. The concerned members shall send the fair questionnaires along with the Manual for the use quickly to the Administration.
- (xi) The questionnaires on the resources available for the Jarawas will be finalized by the members of the Expert Committee as soon as draft questionnaires are submitted by Zoological Survey of India and Botanical Survey of India and Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Port Blair.
- (xii) The Composite Groups shall move in the field in the by 10th first week of December, 2001 and shall cover all the seasons of the year. The been in the field in the been moves to be delet schedule will be compiled been be surely learn moves to be delet an 10th Dec. 2001
- (xiii) Director of Anthropological Survey of India will write to the Medical Anthropologists to obtain the information / report on the health and modern medicines among hunting and gathering tribes elsewhere in the world.
- (xiv) Administration will quickly take up with the Government of India for protection of genetic material (genome) on Jarawas and other matters on research, documentation, filming etc.
- (xv) An affidavit be filed before the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta and pray for one year time period for submission of the report by the Expert Committee and this one year period will commence from the date of the first meeting of the Expert Committee i.e.10.09.2001.
