Sir,

It is to inform that in pursuance of the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta in W.P.No.48 of 1999, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India have constituted an Expert Committee on the Jarawas of Andaman Islands. This Expert Committee under the convenorship of Lt. Governor has decided to send Composite Groups / Research Teams to conduct research among the Jarawas.

It has been further decided that three Composite Teams would be staying with the Jarawas for considerable length of time in the Forest. The Research Teams are required to pitch their camps in the forest.

In this connection, you are requested to lend us three tents for a period of one year or so for the use of these Research Teams. This matter was discussed with you today. The Executive Secretary Andaman Adim Janjati Vikas Samiti is being asked to contact the concerned officer of your department for further action.
