I am directed to inform you that the study teams consisting of multidisciplinary experts will be commencing their study of Jarawas with effect from 10/12/2001 as per the decisions taken by the Expert Committee under the convenorship of Lt. Governor during the meeting held on 6/11/2001. Pre-testing of questionnaires is scheduled to be done in the field on 6th & 7th December,2001.

There will be three teams each consisting of about 15 persons. Each team will be camping in Jarawa forest areas near the Jarawa camps. Following are the broad areas to be covered by three study teams.
