



- (i) The draft questionnaires prepared by Director of Health Services, Professor Indira Chakraborthy of All India Institute of Hygiene and Public Health, Director of Anthropological Survey of India, and Zoological Survey of India, Port Blair were scrutinized by the Members of the Expert Committee. Certain modifications were suggested in the questionnaires on Health and Nutrition.
- (ii) The questionnaires prepared by Botanical Survey of India and Zoological Survey of India require thorough revision as they are incomplete.
- (iii) Members of the Composite Group from Forest Department are required to be adequately senior and should not be below the rank of Range Officer.
- (iv) It is essential to the have members of Zoological Survey of India and Botanical Survey of India in the composite team. Since the local Office of these Surveys are grossly under staffed personnel from other Stations have to be mobilized to participate in the study of Jarawas. So the Administration has to take up the matter with the Directors of those Survey Organisations.
- (v) The questionnaires prepared by Director of Anthropological Survey of India are alright and can be finalized as it is.
- (vii) Experts from All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi and Indian Council of Medical Research need to be associated to study diagnostic approach, drug regimes and long term and short term research requirements with respect to health related aspects of Jarawas.
