- 6. The Composite Groups will study the Jarawas and survey their area during the following three seasons in the year 2001-2002.
 - i. Post monsoon period December, 2001 to February, 2002.

iii. Summer season / dry season - March, 2002 to May, 2002.

iii. Monsoon period - June, 2002 to November, 2002.

- 7. The study will be in the three phases corresponding to the seasons indicated above. The duration of each phase will be such that all the Jarawa bands / groups are covered as far as possible during the each of the three seasons of the year.
- 8. The respective members of the Composite Group shall record their observations in the questionnaires. The members of the Composite Group shall maintain Daily Diary and they shall record their observations of the Jarawas on day to day basis. The filled up questionnaires and Daily Diaries shall be brought back to Port Blair for further analysis and report writing.
- 9. The instant study being the first of its kind in respect of Jarawas of Andaman Islands, the Members of the Composite Groups are expected to be properly motivated and sensitive to the field situation as it is a unique interface between hunting, gathering Jarawa Tribe and the Researchers belonging to modern society. The Members of the Composite Groups therefore are to follow certain **DOs and DONTs**. The illustratative list (not exhaustive) of certain DOs and DONTs is annexed to this Order.

10. The necessary arrangements to facilitate the study of Jarawas by the Composite Groups has been made by the A&N Administration. This issues with the approval of the Andaman and Nicobar Administration.
