- 5. Effort how to be taken to find out if they have the practice of avoiding or consuming extra of any food for some special reason in general or specifically for some family members sometimes.
- 6. This is to be find out if they have any storage practices. For this besides questioning, observation inside the house is needed.

Form No. 6: Water and Sanitation / Housing / Behavior

- 1. Sources of water should be physically checked.
- 2. Storage pot, if any, is to be physically located inside or outside of the house.
- 3. To know their water pouring practices they may be asked to bring a cup of water or observation has to be made while they are drinking water.
- 4. Their bathing practices may be known from observation as well as from the local people.
- 5. Other hygienic practices have to be noted after careful observation.
- 6. Adequate ventilation has to be judged by observation.
- 7. Illumination to be judged from the ability of a person (investigator) to read a book inside the house.
- 8. Information on the presence of insects and rodents may be gathered from interrogation as well as by observation.
- 9. Toilet practices have to be noted after observation...
- 10. To know their behavioral practices observation has to be made.
