Sir,



Therefore, in this connection I am directed to request you to kindly provide the Police as it was down to this Composite Group when it proceeded to Western Coasts of South Andaman Island by M.V.Shompen on 10.12.2001.

Also kindly provide the motor boats placed at the disposal of Jarawa Protection Force at Camp No.4 for the movement of the Police escort and the team. These boats are required in addition to one boat which are already been hired by AAJVS.
