

with small amount of water which was very dirty, this water they use for drinking, it will be better if we dig one or 2 wells near their settlement (hutment) with spade. this will solve the acute shortage of water problem of Jarawa.

Jarawa men were asking from us for small dah (matchets) and small iron penise for making axe which they use for digging tubers & roots from forest which they consume.

All the Jarawa males & females were in happy mood. They played with us for a long time.

Jarawa also showed us their wounds on their body which I suppose they were asking for some ointment etc, which we were unable to provide as no medical staff went with us, it is suggested if we keep some, antibiotic spray to cover wound will be better, which is also not harmful and spend ~~of~~ medical staff for its treatment is not required. We left Jarawa area around 1 PM and reached K/Tall at 2 PM night halt there & left for P/Blair on 27/5/70 and reached P/Blair at about 12 noon same day.
