there. This would give the idea of cooking rice to them and they may do same, when we can supply rice in sufficient quantity. Simultaneously, we may also plant some seedlings of coconut, papaya, mango, guava, orange, etc.

A suitable site for this purpose has been found out at Lakralungta. In future the contacts will be made only in Lakralungta. If this experiment is found successful we propose to spend a night in the camp with the Jarawas. This will be attempted only when the present foul weather ceases, say, some time from October. With our sincere and willful efforts, no doubt, time is not far when we can have a nice colony of Jarawas when we can move with them freely without fear and these tribes can be brought to disciplined and systematic way of life.
