After a few hours we went on board the ship along with the Jarawas. They were given further coconuts, Cooked rice, plantain etc. Some of them were found unwell and they complained of headache, abdomen pain and injuries. They were attended to by the Medical officer and Shri Sukhla and were given treatment. All were very happy but were not so cheerfeul just contary to our posts contacts. Although we could notice about 20-25 at first, but only 17 came to us. One member in their group who was regularly present during the contacts.

Wan not seen this time. He is quite senior member respectable and a/person among them. On enquiry of his absence by Shri Sukhla he was given to understand that the same expired person person few days backs. From the gesture we could make out that this man died of abdominal pain. It seems that the death of this person may be the cause of their melancholy. Probably this might be the reason that all of them did not come except the seventeen. At about 12'0' clock, out their own request, we left them on shore. At the time of our departure from Lakra Lungta they all waved us good-bye and left for their home with all the gifts. We reached Kadamtala at about 1.30 p.m and left for port Blair at 2 p.m. We reached Port Blair at 9.p.m.
