

Coplaings of any Jarawas menace for the past one year. We halted at Kadamtala .

On 13th morning at 6 A.M We proceeded to Lakralugta . Although we planned to start at 5 a.m., but we could not stick to the timing due to fog as the visibility in the creek was poor. On reaching the destination we found a group of Jarawas on the shore at spike ~~It~~ Island is the place where the Jarawas from South which is oposite to Lukra Lugta. The Spike Island is the place where the Jarawas from South Andaman coast come to go to Kadamtala. We went by dunghi to the shore of spike and picked up the Jarawas there. There were sixteen of them and were of new faces . Obviously these Jarawas are from South Andaman . With these sixteen we proceeded to Lakra Lungta where our regular jarawa friends were anxiously waiting. We landed at Lakralungta. The Jarawas picked up from Spike joined their couterparts at Lakra Lungta. There was heavy down pour continuously though-out the day. This caused much inconvenience in our contact. We went with ~~out~~ few Jarawas to the spot which was found ideal for the future halting camp, and made them ~~these~~ clear that we wanted to build sheds for stay and storing gifts. By gesture we found that they were willing to make the shed and might co-operate in our action. Next time we want to make an attempt to build a small shed with jungle materials available there by them.

After spending some time on shore these Jarawas were taken on board Tarmugli by dungi in three trips. There were 106 in number of these tribes as detailed below:-
