1. Consolidation of friendly contacts already established with the Jarawas of Middle Andaman and the Sentinalese of Sentinal Island and to extend and further expand friendly contact with other group of Jarawas in the West Coast with the help of the friendly Jarawas of Middle Andaman.
2. Study of Jarawas and Sentinalese languages ; and
3. Such other work as may be assigned to the cells by the Administration from time to time.
