2. The tribals expressed concern over the difficulty faced by the students from Afra Bay who are studying in Campbell Bay after the Primary School level, as the hostel constructed for the purpose in Campbell is lying un-utilized for a long time.

The Commr-Cum-Secy, PWD issued direction to the Principal, Sr. Sec. School. Campbell Bay to make the hostel facilities functional at the earliest.

(Action: Dir(Edn)/Principal, GSSS, C/Bay)

3. The Secretaries also visited the Primary School in Afra Bay and requested the Principal to immediately send furniture (yet to be assembled in Cbay) for the students from Campbell within a month.

(Action: Principal, GSSS, C/Bay)

2. The tribals demanded for an ANM and a Malaria worker. They also informed that a local youth has already been trained for Malaria Control works and suggested his appointment for the purpose.

(Action: Chairman, DHS, Nicobar/ DPM, NRHM/, C/Nicobar)

The tribals expressed serious concerned over the lack of communication facilities and sought for a BSNL telephone connection at the earliest.

(Action: CGM, BSNL)

4. The tribals demanded for a Community Hall, Birth House, Death House and Recreation Hall in Afra Bay in the same way as provided in other tribal islands like Carnicobar.

(Action: PO (ITDP, C/Nicobar)

- 5. The tribals expressed concern over the irregular Speed Boat services and sought for a regular Speed Boat Service to Afra Bay and other settlement area in Little Nicobar.
- 6. The tribals also sought for a retaining wall adjacent to the school building as they fear a land slide. In response to this, the EE, APWD informed that he has already inspected the site and prepared an estimate in June, 2012 and is awaiting administrative approval for the same.
