Health card introduced by AAJVS is maintained by the Tribal Welfare officer. The same is updated by the Medical officer, PHC, C/Bay.

In the evening proceeded to New Chingen village and met the Shompens. There were three Shompen family including two orphan boys being fostered by Smti. Lidia, a Nicobarese lady. Smti. Rosy and the orphan boys demanded for employment and house hold items.

Later, met Shri. Kimos and Shri. George, the Captain and vice-captain of New Chingen village. They informed that during removal of trees dangerous poised over their permanent shelters, one tree fell over their shelter and totally damaged them.

Met the Senior Veterinary Surgeon. He informed that his department has provided poultry units to the Shompens at Lawful ad New Chingen. The Shompens only like grown birds. They shall be providing poultry, piggery and Turkey / duck units during the month of April-May 2013 when they are gown old.

Before Tsunami, plantations containing fruit bearing trees were planted and raised for the Shompens and were frequently maintained by Agriculture department. But after Tsunami, maintenance work has not been taken up.
