- 4) Construct of semi-permanent structures at three locations viz.. 24 KM North-South Road, 37 Km East-West Road, Lawful Bay. The eco-hut at 16 KM East-West Road may also be converted into semi-permanent structure. These four structures shall be utilized as contact points for extending health coverage to the Shompen, supply of ration articles etc.
- (Action: APWD)
- 5) Posting of one Pharmacist exclusively for extending medical coverage to the Shompens
- (Action: AAJVS)
- 6) To discourage Shompens from visiting to Campbell Bay and bartering resulting in their exploitation, ration articles may be supplied through the contact points.
- (Action: AAJVS)
- 7) Medical team consisting of specialists like Chest, TB and pathologists from Port Blair may visit Shompen habitats once in every quarter and conduct detailed clinical examination.
- (Action: DHS)
- 8) The permanent shelter at New Chingen village requires minor repairs, replacement of toilet accessories etc.
- (Action: APWD)
- 9) Maintenance of plantation to be undertaken and fruit bearing trees to be planted in and around Shompen habitats
- (Action: Agriculture department)
- 10) Poultry birds, piggery units to be supplied to Shompens under the tribal sub-plan
- (Action: DAH&VS)
- 11) Proper documentation of Shompen culture, Folklore, ethno-medicines etc needs to be carried out.
- (Action: AAJVS)
