**MEMORANDUM**

During my tour to Jarawa area alongwith Shri. S.A. Awaradi, Member, Research Advisory Board, Andaman & Nicobar Tribal Research and Training Institute, it was found that the expiry date of some of the medicines is September, 2014 i.e such medicines will become ineffective very soon. Administering such medicines to the Jarawas may turn fatal.

Therefore, the Pharmacist may be directed to take care not to administer such medicines. Secondly the medicines whose expiry date is short should not be received since the AAJVS units are located at far of places.

A compliance report on the action taken must be submitted by the Tribal Welfare Officer's and Pharmacists of respective areas within three days from the date of receipt of this memorandum
