

II Inspection of the Tribal Ward in G.B.Pant Hospital and Adibasera on 20.7.2014

- (7) The AAJVS staff posted in the G.B. Pant Hospital was found on duty. The Great Andamanese child S/o Smti Leechu is admitted in the hospital.
- (8) The Andamanese mentioned about certain issues / problems pertaining to them including the following:-
- (i) The water in the well at the Strait Island is not healthy because many of the Andamanese are suffering from severe skin diseases. Therefore, there is a immediate need test the water by the PWD and the Health Department. Accordingly we may write to them quickly.
 - (ii) On inspection of the Adibasera it was found that the repairs are going on.
 - (iii) There is a urgent need to raise retaining wall at the back side of the Adibasera since erosion due to drain particularly due to storm water is severe and likely to affect the Adibasera itself.
 - (iv) It is felt that there is a need to provide affordable accommodation for the employees of the AAJVS who are called on official work to Port Blair from their respective field areas. Now a days such employs cannot afford to stay in the lodges.
 - (v) In this connection it would be advisable to have a Guest-House Barrack in the Adibasera Complex. There is a piece of land available on one side towards ANIIDCO which can be used for the Guest-House Barrack.
