A prescribed format containing the required details, i.e name of the Shompen, age, sex, fathers name, mothers name, area of ⁱⁿhabitation shall be prepared and sent to Campbell Bay for starting the work.

The existing staff of AAJVS will accompany the above two persons. AAJVS will provide a digital camera to take the photographs.

- 3) It was opined that construction of East-West Road should not be taken up in the interest of the Shompen. The Coast Guard may make a base for security on the west side of the island for which a road cutting the east to west is not required.
- 4) The Assistant Commissioner, Campbell Bay informed that prior to Tsunami there were case^s of poaching in the Island. Mutual trading / barter was in vogue. But after Tsunami all the localities are dwelling in and around Campbell Bay, they have no contacts with the poachers. Therefore, presently, there are no cases of poaching.

The Station House Officer, Campbell Bay stated that a watch group of fishermen has been constituted who inform the Coast Guard. Since, Police do not have a boat, the services of Coast Guard has become mandatory.

- 5) Secretary (TW) informed that there are 5 to 6 children of the age of 10 years and above asking for higher education. But there is no middle school at Chingen village.

The Assistant Commissioner, Campbell Bay stated that presently there is no scheme for up-gradation of the school at Chingen. He assured that the matter will be taken up with APWD for inclusion in the annual plan. He added that once the work for construction of road is complete, it would be easier for the students to come to Campbell Bay for higher studies.
