2. Construction of Retaining Wall on the backyard of 10 numbers Type-III Ouarters being constructed for Great Andamanese:

10 Nos. Type-III Quarters being constructed are on a higher altitude and due to earth cutting, soil erosion is taking place in the backyard of these quarters. The Executive Engineer CD-I, APWD explained that construction of a retaining wall to stop soil erosion and consequent damage to these buildings is essential. He was requested to prepare estimate for the same to be taken up in the second phase.

3. Shifting of Power House:-

The Electricity Department has taken over its new buildings (3 Nos.) constructed of Pre-fab materials and Junior Engineer, Havelock accompanying the team stated that the Power House presently functioning in the Poultry Farm building shall be shifted to the new building by 20th November 2007. The Electricity Department may ensure this and also the rearrangement of lines for transmission of power.

4. Re-Opening of Poultry Farm :-.

Dr. R.K Upadhyay, VAS stated that as soon as the Electricity Department shifts the power house and the building of poultry farm is available, the Poultry Farm will be re-opened. At present one Great Andamane lady Mrs. Ria is an employee of Veterinary Services Department, who is undergoing training at Port Blair. After her training she will be posted at Strait Island as per the decision of the Executive Council.

Opening of a Piggery Unit:-

Pork is one of the delicacies of most of the primitive Tribes including Great Andamanese. But, the availability of wild pig at Strait Island as well as nearby Islands is reduced to almost nil. As such, it is proposed to start a piggery unit as one of the self sustenance measures for the primitive tribe. Smti Surmai, the Chief of Great Andamanese Tribes requested that Shri Yerambo, a Great Andamanese unemployed youth may be engaged as an employee
