In the tsunami occurred on 26-12-2004 the residential area near shore at PTG settlement, Strait Island where Great Andamanese are settled was also badly affected.

Initially in order to repair 8 Nos. of Andamanese houses and for construction of two Nos. RCC Ring Well for drinking water a sum of ₹ 13.30 lakhs was deposited by AAJVS in June, 2005 out of Grant-in-Aid.

Subsequently for repairing and painting of existing other residential quarters, Guest House and school building plus additional amount for repair of existing Great Andamanese houses, an amount of $\stackrel{?}{\sim}$ 6.52 lakks was deposited by AAJVS in January, 2006.

At the same time i.e in Jan.,2006 a sum of ₹ 67.69 lakhs was also deposited by AAJVS out of Grant-in-Aid for 'Construction of new buildings for School, Guest House, Medical Sub-Center, Police Wireless and Poultry Farm.'

For another work namely 'Construction of Sea Wall' a sum of ₹ 168.38 lakhs was deposited by AAJVS out of Grant-in-Aid in Feb., 2007. Thus in total AAJVS deposited a sum of ₹ 2,55,91,057/- (Rupees Two crores fifty five lakhs ninety one thousand fifty seven only)

In addition to the above the Directorate of Tribal Welfare sanctioned and conveyed to APWD an amount of ₹ 187 lakhs under M.H 2254 (Tsunami Rehabilitation Package) in January, 2006. As such the total amount sanctioned / deposited by AAJVS and Directorate of Tribal Welfare to APWD comes to ₹ 4,42,91,057/- (Rupees Four crores forty two lakhs ninety one thousand and fifty seven only).

While the works of repair and painting of the old buildings were carried out in 2005, the works regarding construction of new buildings (residential houses of Andamanese, staff quarters and
