192	<p>This is a letter from Shri. N.A. Khan, Ld. Advocate enclosing a certified copy of Writ Petition No: 4358 of 2011 in Swapan Sarkar Vs. The A&N Administration. The Principal Secretary (TW) has directed to submit the same on file.</p> <p>Shri. Swapan Sarkar is a civil contractor working for APWD. He was awarded civil works at Great Andamanese Settlement Strait Island. His bills worth Rs.51.00 lakhs is pending with the APWD, hence he filed a Writ petition in the Hon'ble High Court and made AAJVS a party to the same. Since the stand of AAJVS is quite clear and APWD has informed that they have sufficient funds (para 163-164/N), necessary A-I-O was filed. The Hon'ble Court disposed off the case on 16/3/2012 directing APWD to make necessary payment to the petitioner within 2 month from date. As such, there is no obligation on the part of AAJVS.</p> <p>Meanwhile, the Ld. Public Prosecutor has submitted a bill for the above case, placed at page 157/C for RS.16,880/- (Rupees sixteen thousand eight hundred and eighty only) towards consultation, drafting, attending the hearing etc. Necessary entries posted at page 130-131 of the periodical charge register to avoid any duplication of payment.</p> <p>File is submitted for kind information of Principal Secretary (TW) and approval of an expenditure sanction of <u>Rs.16,880/-</u> please.</p> <p>Submitted for approval please.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">ES, AAJVS</p>
