AAJVS had engaged 15 Mazdoors on contract basis for the welfare and protection of the Jarawas since 1998 onwards. Out of the 15, 2 employees have since expired and 3 were removed from service for their conduct /services. During the visit of Hon'ble Union Minister for Commerce and Industries to Jarawa Reserve areas, he felt that the designation Mazdoor does not suit these hardworking employees and therefore recommended for change in designation and enhancement of salary. This issue was placed before the Executive Council meeting of AAJVS held during August 2007 and it was resolved that the posts of Mazdoors may be re-designated as "Field Attendants". It was also resolved that AAJVS shall prepare Recruitment rules for Field Attendants and appoint these staff on contract basis as Field Attendants. (May please see page 22/C).

Now, since, there are 10 Mazdoors (09 male and 01 female), redesignated as Field Attendants already engaged on contract basis, we require to fill up the remaining five vacant posts (01 male and 04 female). We require female staff for day time watch and ward duties at Jarawa wards at Kadamtala, Tushnabad, G. B. Pant Hospital and Onge ward at R.K. Pur.

Aforesaid is the reasons as to why this Samiti is proposing to fill only 05 posts of Field Attendants please.
