The matter discussed in the notes from para 1 to 48 from pre pages relating to three proposals indicated in the notes at para 40/n of the AAJVS, A&N Islands have been perused:-

Regarding the proposal at para 40(a), for framing of recruitment rules for the post of Field Attendant, it may be stated that the proposal made in the draft recruitment rules of the said post placed at page 16-19/c have been examined with reference to the instructions contained in DoP&T's OM dated 18.3.88, 25.5.98 and the observations/modifications to be carried out in the draft RRs are indicated in the comparative statement attempted by Personnel Wing placed in the file at Flag-K.

In regards to the proposal at para 40(b), for conversion of one out of three posts of Plantation In-charge as Light Vehicle Driver, it may be stated that the Samiti may in the first instance examine and justify as to whether the very purpose of creation of the posts of Plantation In-charge is not defeated by conversion of one post as Light Vehicle Driver and thereafter necessary order to this effect may be issued at their level with the approval of the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands, *in case it is found that the conversion is justified.*

In so far as the proposal at para 40 (c) for filling up of vacancies as at para 39/n, the Samiti has to initiate necessary action at their level to fill up these posts as per provision contained in the recruitment rules of respective posts. However, it may be pointed out here that perusal of records made available in the file at page 1 to 12/c reveals that the recruitment rules for 22 various categories of post have been framed by issuing executive order No. 92 dated 21.7.1987 and 115 dated 25.7.1996 which <sup>is</sup> found to be not in consonance with the guideline on framing of recruitment rules issued by GOI, DoP&T. In fact the recruitment rules are to be notified in the Andaman and Nicobar Gazette with the approval of Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands. Further the provision prescribed in the existing recruitment rules also require to be reviewed and updated to suit present functional requirement of the organization. It is therefore suggested that the Samiti may initiate simultaneous action to review and update the existing recruitment rules.
