In addition to the above, two new posts of Light Vehicle Driver in the scale of pay of Rs.3050-4590 have been created in the Executive Council meeting of AAJVS - held on 12/8/2008 which are also required to be filled in alongwith other posts.

Draft Recruitment Rules for the post of Field Attendant created during 2007 August were made and submitted for vetting by the Personnel Department. While the Personnel Department has carried out vetting, it has been further suggested that old/existing Recruitment Rules for all posts of AAJVS may also be reviewed as per the instruction of DoPT and notify afresh in the form of Gazette Notification as the earlier Recruitment Rules were just in the shape of Administrative order/circular.


Consequent upon the advice of the Personnel Wing, a committee was constituted vide order No.73 dated 13/5/2008 to review the Recruitment Rules and based on the recommendation of the said Committee, Recruitment Rules have also been redrafted and are placed at Flag "DFA".

As regards the suggestion of Mr. Justin, HOO Anthropological Survey of India Office, Port Blair appearing at para 79/n, this was already discussed during the course of review and other 2 members i.e.ES AAJVS and RO (TW) had categorically expressed the opinion that while prescribing the minimum qualification of Anthropology, M.S.W or Sociology is relevant, inclusion of equalent qualification in "linguistics" is not relevant to the requirement of the posts of the AAJVS specifically dealing only. Therefore, the same is not included in the draft Recruitment Rules.
