

During the meeting of the Committee comprising of Executive Secretary, AAJVS, Research Officer, Directorate of Tribal Welfare and Head of Office, Anthropological Survey of India Office, Port Blair, which reviewed the old Recruitment Rules, Head of Office, Anthropological Survey of India had suggested to include the subject "Linguistics" also as one of the educational qualification for the posts of Tribal Welfare Officer. This was disagreed in the meeting itself as for any of the posts of AAJVS while the subjects of "Anthropology", "Social Work" or "Sociology" are relevant, there is no relevance of "Linguistics".
