

RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF
TRIBAL WELFARE OFFICER

1. Name of the Post : Tribal Welfare Officer.
2. No. of post : 4 (four) subject to variation depending upon the work load.
3. Classification : Non-pensionable
4. Scale of Pay : Rs. 1640-60-2600-EB-75-2900
5. Whether Selection or non-selection post : Not applicable.
6. Whether benefit of added years of service admissible under rule 30 of the CCS (pension) Rules, 1972. : Not applicable.
7. Age-limit for contractual appointment : 18 - 35 years
 Note :- The crucial date for determining the age-limit will be the last date upto which the employment exchange is asked to submit the names.
8. Educational and other qualifications required for contractual appointment : Essential : Post Graduate in Anthropology or M.S.W. from recognised University.
 Desirable : 2 years of research work or work experience in tribal area.
9. Whether age and educational qualification prescribed for direct recruit will apply in the case of promotion. : Not applicable.
10. Period of probation if any : 2 years, in case of promotees.
11. Method of recruitment whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/transfer and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods. : (i) 50% by direct recruitment on Contract,
 (ii) 50% by promotion from amongst the Social Workers of AAJVS, failing which by contractual appointment.
