NOTIFICATION

Port Blair, dated the 10th July, 2006.

No. 123/06/F.No. 1-876/2006-TW.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India read with Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. U. 14039/2/83-ANL 21st February, 1985, and in supersession to this Administration's Notification No. 129/88/No. 1-507/87-TW dated 21st January 1988, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of **Research Officer (Junior)** in the Directorate of Tribal Welfare, Andaman and Nicobar Administration, namely :—

1. Short Title and Commencement:—

- i) These rules may be called Andaman and Nicobar Islands Research Officer (Junior) Recruitment Rules, 2006.
- ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay:—

The number of posts, their classification and scale of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified at Sl. Nos. 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc:—

The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified at Sl. No. 5 to 14 of the said schedule aforesaid.

4. Disqualifications:—

No person,

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person, having a spouse living, or
- (b) Who having a spouse, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, if satisfied such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are grounds for on doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax :—

Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect of any class or category of persons.
