Expeditious steps may, therefore, be taken to fill up the vacancies through Employment Exchange as well as open vacancy notification.

On careful examination, it is found that although three posts of Tribal Welfare Officer (02 promotion and 01 direct recruitment quota) are vacant, only one post of direct recruitment quota can be filled in as the pay and allowances of two Social Workers are being drawn against two vacant posts of Tribal Welfare Officer direct (promotion quota.)

Further, in respect of one vacant post of a Plantation-in-Charge, it is stated that the a decision has been taken by Executive Council that same is not required as the in-charge of tribal settlements at Dugong Creek, SouthBay and Strait Island takes care of the whole affairs including the coconut plantations. This post may be converted to "Light Vehicle Driver" as AAJVS is having only post of LVD as against three light vehicles. Pay scale of both the posts i.e.. Plantation-in-Charge and Light vehicle Driver being the same i.e 3050-4590, there is no additional financial implications and it is also permissible under rules. Hon'ble Lt. Governor is the competent authority for the same.

Three posts of Medical Officer and 3 posts of Pharmacist need not be filled inview of the position explained at para 30/N above.
