Proposed Activities:

Comprehensive Primary Health care and referrals

- 1. Training two ASHAs selected among tribal girls.
- 2. A Staff Nurse (Nurse practitioner) will be posted to the clinic
- 3. Nurse will be trained for taking care of mothers & child health care needs. She will provide preventive, promotive and curative health services. She will be trained as Nurse practitioner
- 4. An MBBS/Ayush doctor would visit once a week.
- 5. Nurse would have phone connection for getting guidance from the medical officer.
- 6. All members of each household will be screened and individual case records will be maintained.
- 7. Traditional health practices would be studied and included in Primary Health Care. One of the ASHA will be trained in the traditional practices.
- 8. An Essential drug list and Standard treatment guidelines will be prepared and train the health workers and Medical officers to use them.
- System would be developed for referring patients to Port Blair Hospital. Guidelines would be prepared for the management of referred cases.
- 10. Andaman Aadim Jati Vikas Samiti (AAJVS) will manage the health centre and Karuna Trust will work to improve the health system.
- 11.ANM & Staff Nurse to be provided by AAJVS or Health department
- 12. Training:
 - Orientation training for medical officer visiting the island.
 - Induction training for Staff Nurse or ANM.
 - One month training for ASHAs
