The trustees shall, where any aid is proposed to be given for charitable purposes, to any institution, association, society, organisation, body or trust, ascertain that the objects of such institution, Association, society, organisation, body or trust are accordance with the objects of this trust and, if so, satisfied, may give donation to such institution, association, society, organisation, body or trust for being utilised only for such objects. The surplus and unapplied portion of the said income, if any, arising in any one or more years or years shall be accumulated and/or invested inaccordance with the provisions of the Income-tax Act, 1961, as may be in force from time to time.

For the accomplishment of the objects of the trust as expressed in this deed and without prejudice to the generality of any powers hereby or by law conferred or implied or vested in the trustees, the following powers and authorities are hereby expressly conferred on the Trustees:-

1. To appoint any one from amongst them as Managing Trustee with such powers as may be delegated to him or her from time to time, by way of resolution passed by a majority of the trustees. The number of trustees shall not be less than 'THREE' and shall not be more than 'TEN' at any time. The filling up of the vacancy casued by resignation/death of a Trustee, or any new appointment to the Office of the trustee, shall be by a resolution accepted by the majority of the trustees.
