

15.0 CESSATION AND REMOVAL OF MEMBERSHIP:

15.1 A person shall cease to be a member of the KARUNA TRUST (R) on his death, or

15.2 On his resignation in writing and acceptance of the same by the Managing Committee of the Trust, or

15.3 On his being mentally disabled or incapacitated to enter into contractual obligation, or

15.4 On his failure to pay the subscription within the due period.

15.5 Any person whose activities are considered detrimental to the interests of the Trust can be removed from the membership of the Trust by a decision of the majority of the members present and voting at the meeting of the General Body of the Trust specially convened for the purpose. The quorum for such a meeting shall be two thirds of the total number of the members or 20 whichever is less.

15.6 Those members whose names appear on the list of members of the Trust as on the date of fixing the date of General Body at the meeting of the Managing Committee, shall be entitled to vote in the General Body Meeting.

15.7 A separate register for all classes of members shall be maintained.

16.0 FUNDS:

The KARUNA TRUST (R) shall raise its funds:

16.1 By membership fees.

16.2 By entrance fees.

16.3 By grants, donations and contributions from members or public.

16.4 By raising loans for such period and any such rate of interest as may be decided by the Managing Committee of the KARUNA TRUST (R).
